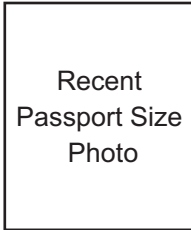

FACILITIES

HOSTEL

Well furnished Hostels (UG & PG) are situated inside the college campus. The rooms are available for all UG, PG students. The hostel provides hygienic pure vegetarian food using the latest steam technology.

The hostel has regular supply of ordinary and hot water with parallel tap system for drinking and bathing.

On demand, special rooms with attached bath are also provided to the inmates.

TRANSPORT

The management operating a fleet of Buses and Vans, numbering more than 130 for easy mobility of the students from different parts of the districts of Namakkal, Erode, Salem and Karur.

LIBRARY

1. The library is kept open from 8.30am to 7.30pm on all working days without break.
2. Strict Silence should be observed in the library.
3. Personal belongings such as bags, tiffin boxes, notes etc should be left at the entrance of the library.
4. Member of Teaching faculty can borrow up to 7 books at a time.
5. Member of Non-Teaching staff may borrow not more than 2 books at a time.
6. All UG Students will be given 2 tickets, PG 3 tickets. Books will be issued to students & Staff only on exchange of tickets.

7. Lending Period :

Staff - 30 days

Students :

UG - 10 days

PG - 15 days

Books may be renewed for the further period if there is no demand for them from other students.

8. Reference books such as dictionary, encyclopedia, and books labeled, as reference will not be lent.
9. Students & Staff should not damage, write or make any mark on any books or periodicals belonging to the library.
10. If a book is lost or missing, the borrower shall either pay 2 times of its cost or replace it with a new copy.
11. Students & Staff must examine the book on receiving it and report to the librarian about any damage found therein. Otherwise the borrower will be responsible for the damage.
12. Tickets are not transferable. Sub-lending of books is also forbidden.
13. Students & Staff should return all books borrowed from the library one week before the last working day of the academic year.
14. Loss of tickets should be reported to the Librarian who will issue duplicate on payment Rs.50/- per ticket.
15. Theft, vandalism and destruction of library books, journals and related materials are also considered as serious offences and those who cause such offences will be dealt with seriously.
16. Students & Staff should take care of their purses, key bunches, diaries, notebooks etc, while they are in the library. The library is not responsible for any claim of loss or damage to such articles.
17. This is your library. It is your responsibility to keep it neat and tidy, and create a conducive atmosphere for reading.

BANK

Indian Overseas Bank has its extension counter in separate wing within the campus. The students and the staff can operate accounts. ATM facility is also available in the bank.

CANTEEN

The College Canteen caters to the taste of the students and the staff with fresh and hygienic food. The canteen provides eatables, fruit juice, soft drinks, food varieties and stationary items.

The users should collect the bill to receive the things. The canteen is fitted with television for relaxation. There are separate regions for the staff and the students.

SUGGESTION BOX

The management has installed suggestion boxes in the college and in the hostel. The students and the staff members may use the box for the representation of their genuine problems / grievances to the management. Also, general suggestions for the improvement of the institution may be put in the box.

HOSPITAL

The Management sponsors an Eye care hospital and a General hospital. They are dedicated to Medical Service. Sick students will be treated as out patients or admitted in the hospitals for treatment.

OTHER AMENITIES

- ◆ The College and the hostel have uninterrupted power supply with high power generators. All laboratories have UPS for continuous functioning.
- ◆ The Management has installed a mineral water unit for the supply of drinking water to the college and the hostel round the clock.
- ◆ There is a STD Center with multi-lines in the campus for the use of all.

EXTRA CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

- ◆ The students are encouraged to develop their sportive spirit. Interested sports persons are given special training to participate in various sports activities / competitions outside the college.

- ◆ All UG and PG students are given one-day pleasure tour, with staff members.
- ◆ The cultural and the artistic talents of the students are brought out with opportunities for expression and exhibition to the society.
- ◆ Environmented Education Citizenship \ Camp is arranged.

ACADEMIC CODE

- ◆ Classes commence at 9.30 am and close at 4.00 pm
- ◆ Attendance will be taken twice a day at the beginning of FN & AN Session hours.
- ◆ Students should attend the classes regularly. No student should absent.
- ◆ Herself from the class without prior permission from the class teacher and the Head of the Department.
- ◆ Student should have a minimum of 80% attendance for being allowed to University exam.
- ◆ The leave letter must be counter-signed by parents or by warden in the case of hosteller. In the case of sick leave, medical certificate must be produced.
- ◆ Continuous absence of a Student for more than 3 days will be intimated to the parents immediately.
- ◆ Monthly tests are conducted for all the UG and PG classes. Every month.
- ◆ Students should make active participation in all functions / seminar classes organized by the College.
- ◆ After the completion of the academic cycle, Students shall write Three Model exams.
- ◆ All PG final year students should do dissertation work.
- ◆ Special classes on communication English is conducted for the year UG and PG students. Also, spoken English classes are conducted for all the students who have come from Tamil medium schools.

DURATION OF THE B.Ed., & M.Ed., COURSE (2 YEARS)

The course duration is two academic years. Each year consisting of 200 working days / curriculum transaction days or 1200 hours (6 days per week @ 6 hours per day) excluding admission and examination days. In the second year, 200 working days will include teaching practice. For both the years revision examination and study holidays will include.

ATTENDANCE

Each candidate whose admission is approved by Tamil Nadu Teachers Education University should gain 85% i.e. 170 days) of attendance, failing which they will not be permitted to appear for the B.Ed., & M.Ed., degree examination (both written and Practical Examination for B.Ed.,)

CODE OF CONDUCT IN THE COLLEGE

- ◆ Students should wear uniform sarees for becoming cultured personality. College function days they may castum un uniform.
- ◆ Students should follow the widely acceptable code of behaviour.
- ◆ All students should show obedience and respect to the teachers. Students should salute the teacher and the management people on seeing them for the first time every day.
- ◆ When teachers enter/leave the class room, the students should stand up as a mark of respect.
- ◆ All students have the responsibility of keeping the campus clean.
- ◆ Students should stand away from improper activities that may pollute the peaceful atmosphere of the campus.
- ◆ Problems of any sort may be reported to the principal/the management through proper channel.
- ◆ Free time, if available, must be spent in the library in a way useful for academic progress.

- ◆ Students should maintain cordial, friendly and congenial relationship among themselves.
- ◆ Various amenities provided by the management should be properly utilized.
- ◆ Free transport service.
- ◆ Free Transport service is rendered and all students should travel only by the college bus.
- ◆ Students who travel by college bus should produce the free bus pass on demand. Free pass will be given for one bus and particular stop only.
- ◆ They should keep the ID card in their safe custody. In case of loss of the pass/card, duplicate pass/card can be obtained by paying Rs. 50/-
- ◆ All students should have gathered in the class before the teacher's arrival. The students who come to the class after the arrival of the teacher will not be allowed.
- ◆ While moving from the classroom to the library, the students should maintain silence so as not to disturb other classes.
- ◆ Students should treat/handle the college properties as their own. Improper use and damage thereon of any will be recovered from the students .
- ◆ Students should regularly watch the notice boards in the department and in the college office for notices and circulars of all sorts.
- ◆ Students who do not travel by college bus should sign in the main gate register while entering and leaving the college.
- ◆ The day scholars should obtain "VISITOR'S PASS" from the office and the parents will be allowed only with the pass.
- ◆ Visitors should sign and collect the entry pass at the gate.
- ◆ The disciplinary committee consisting of staff members will watch the discipline of the students. If any student is found indisciplinary, the committee will discuss and send its recommendations to the management.

CODE OF CONDUCT IN THE HOSTEL

- ◆ Two separate hostels function in the campus for both UG and PG students.
- ◆ Students seeking admission to the hostel may contact the warden.
- ◆ Hostellers are not allowed to vacate the hostel in the mid year in certain cases, if they are allowed, they must pay the bus fees to come as day scholars.
- ◆ Students should maintain the mess timings

FOR DECLARED HOLIDAYS

- ◆ Mess bill reduction will be given only when the holidays is going to be a minimum of 4 days .
- ◆ No reduction in the mess bill will be given for the Saturdays and Sundays.
- ◆ Full mess bill reduction will be given for the days which is falling between the last university Exam and commencement of the next semester.

GENERAL RULES

- ◆ Hostellers should obtain pass for visitors (maximum three persons in number) at the time of admission and without "VISITOR'S PASS" no one will be allowed to contact the inmates.
- ◆ Visitors are allowed only on Sundays.
- ◆ Only parents and guardians as in the visitor's card will be allowed to contact the inmates.
- ◆ Inmates will be allowed to go home during the holidays only.

- ◆ However, this rule is relaxable in sick-cases.
- ◆ Students in ill health should immediately report to the warden for medical treatment.
- ◆ The inmates are not allowed to remain in the hostel room during the working hours. However the sick are exempted from this with prior permission from the warden.
- ◆ PCO with multi-telephone lines functions at the hostel reception hall for the comfort of all inmates.
- ◆ Only the parents are allowed to contact the inmates over phone. Call from others are not entertained.
- ◆ Students can make telephone calls during the following hours.

On Week Days	-	7.00 a.m. to 10.30 p.m.
On Sundays	-	7.00 a.m. to 1.00 p.m. 2.00 p.m. to 5.00 p.m .
- ◆ While leaving the room, the inmates should switch off all the lights and fans .
- ◆ When the students return to the hostel after holidays, they should reach before 6.00 p.m. OUTING. IS NOT ALLOWED.
- ◆ Students' letters will be posted/delivered only after scrutiny.
- ◆ The warden reserves the rights to inspect the room and the things of inmates at any time.
- ◆ Ragging is a punishable offence. If anybody found involved in ragging, she will be immediately expelled from the college and hostel.
- ◆ Students should not conduct any function or anything like that without the knowledge of the warden. They should not put up anything on the notice board or at any other place .
- ◆ Inmates should not keep a large amount of cash, gold or any other costly ornaments in their rooms. The management will not hold any responsibility for the loss of things if any.
- ◆ Visitors should bring their identity cards. Otherwise they will not be allowed.

- ◆ Visitors are not allowed to enter the rooms of the students.
- ◆ Students are allowed to talk only with their visitors and not with the visitors of other students. If they do so, that visitor's name will be cancelled from the visitor's card .
- ◆ For “Send only with Parents” - Students : Telephone messages, letters, telegrams etc. from the parents are not accepted to send the students from the hostel. Parents / Guardians who come to take the students with them should produce the visitor's card.
- ◆ If a student vacates the hostel, she should collect her things within a month.
- ◆ After given admission to the hostel, students are not allowed to come as day scholars even for 1 or 2 days.
- ◆ Parents should avoid sending money through courier services. For any loss, the management will not be responsible.
- ◆ The possession / use of cell phone is not permitted in the campus, if cell phone is found with any student it will be ceased and will not be returned for any reasons.
- ◆ All should maintain peace and silence with proper adherence to the codes of conduct framed by the management.
- ◆ The decision of the management is final on all matters.

RAGGING PREVENTION RULES
EXTRACT OF ACT NO. 7 OF 1997

An Act to prohibit "Ragging" in Educational Institutions in the state of Tamil Nadu. Short title, extent and commencement

1. This Act may be called the Tamil Nadu Prohibition of Ragging Act 1997.
2. It extends to the whole the State of Tamil Nadu.
3. It shall be deemed to have come into force on the 19th day of December 1996.

DEFINITION

In this Act unless the context otherwise requires, 'Ragging' means display of noisy disorderly conduct or doing any act which causes or is likely to cause physical or psychological harm or raise apprehension or fear or shame or embarrassment to a student in any Educational Institution and includes, teasing, abusing of, playing practical jokes on, or causing hurt to such students or asking the student to do any act or perform something which such student will not in the ordinary course willingly do.

PROHIBITION OF RAGGING

Ragging within or outside the educational institution is prohibited.

PENALTY FOR RAGGING

Whoever directly or indirectly commits, participates in, abets or propagates 'ragging' within or outside any Educational institution, shall be punished with imprisonment for a term which may extend to two years and shall also be liable to a fine which may extend to ten thousand rupees.

DISMISSAL OF STUDENT

Any student convicted of an offence under section 4 shall also be dismissed from the educational Institution and such student shall not be admitted in any other Educational Institution.

SUSPENSION OF STUDENT

1. Without prejudice to the foregoing provisions, whenever any student complaints of ragging to the Head of an Educational institutions, or to any other person responsible for the management of the Educational Institution, Such head of the Educational Institution or person responsible for the management of the Educational Institution shall enquire into the same immediately and if found true shall suspend the student, who has committed the offence, from the Educational institution.
2. The decision of the Head of the Educational Institution or the person responsible for the management of the Educational Institution on any student. indulged in ragging under sub-section (1) shall be final.

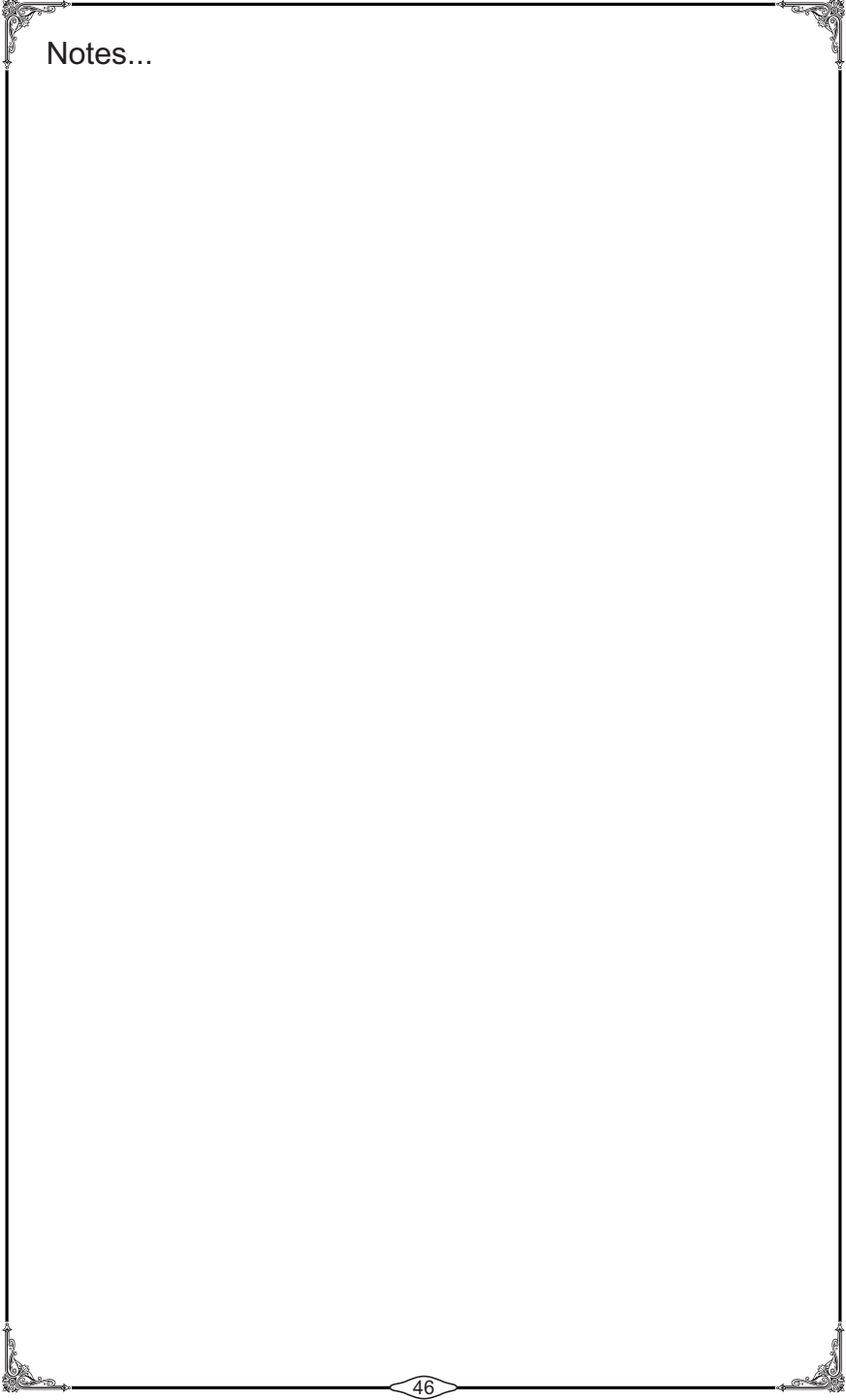

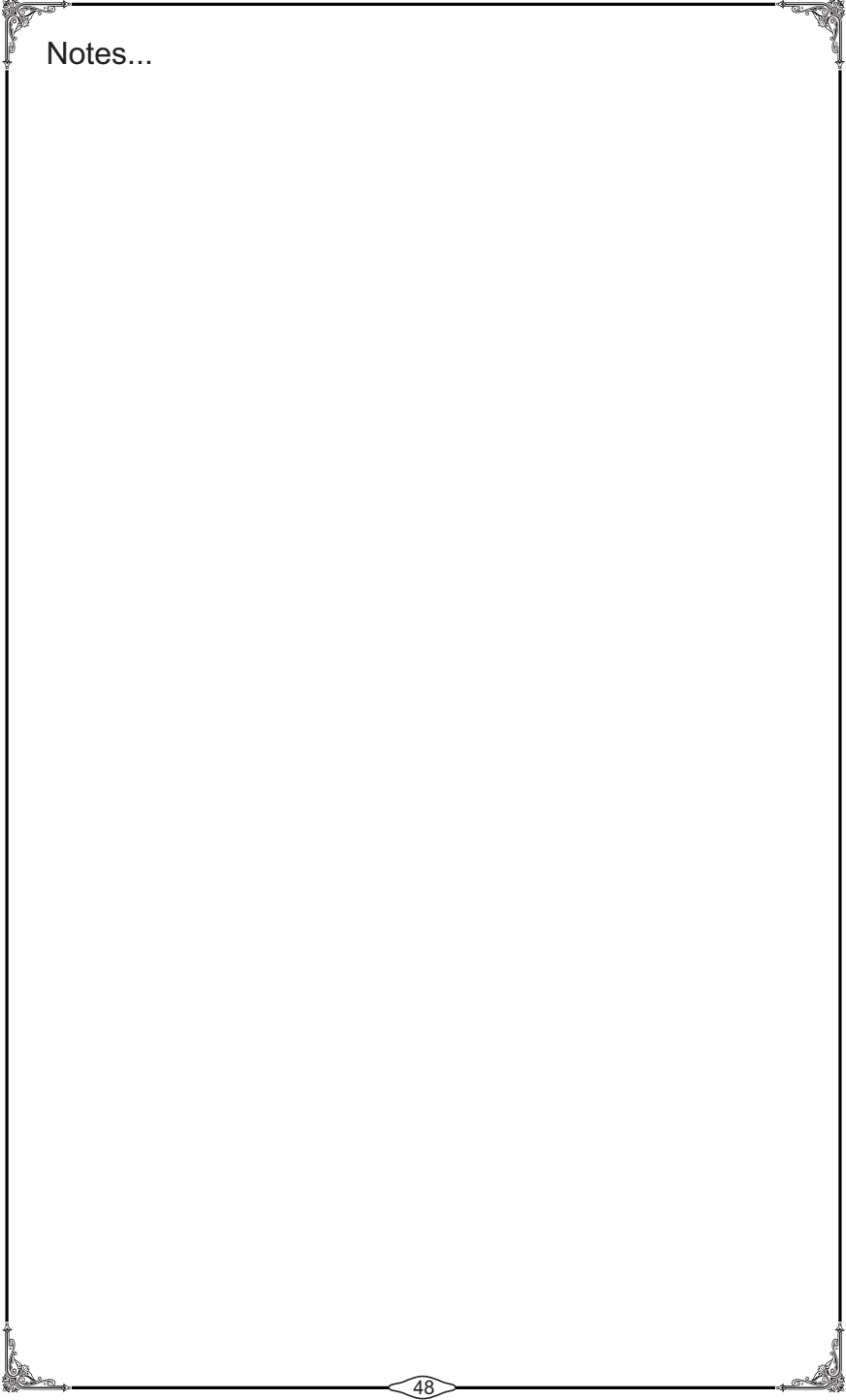

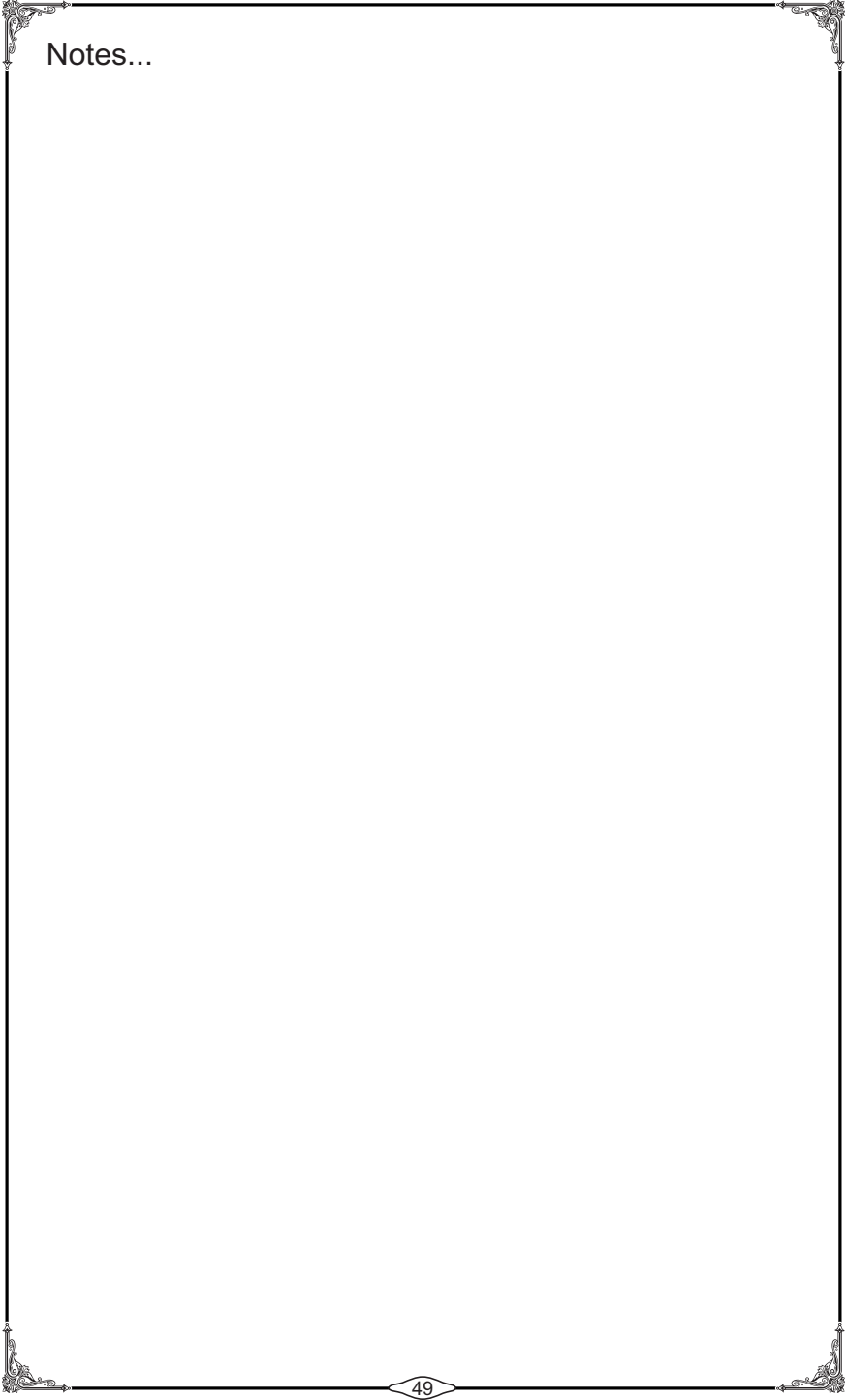
